

In the first of selected programs to see out 2007, a popular request from members was that of copying and burning CD and DVD discs. President Noel demonstrated various programs so that members could consider which would be suitable to their own needs. Using "Roxio" and "Nero" as basic programs others were "DVD Fab", "DVD Shrink" and "Memories on TV". Most important of course is when preparing to burn you will be asked to click on "PAL" or "NTSC" for playback. "PAL" is our local system in Australia and plays at 25 frames-a-second where-as "NTSC" is used in the USA and Canada and plays at 30 frames-a second, also important is to have adequate space on your hard disc with 80 or more Gigabyte suggested.
